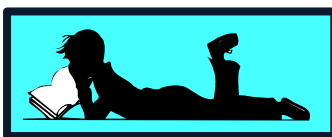


**Ask your Principal or Daycare Technician

Lester B. Pearson School Board offers quality school-based daycares subsidized by the Ministry of Education. Only those pre-school and elementary school students duly registered in a school board and who are receiving instructional services may be eligible for school daycare services during the school year. To be eligible for the \$7 per day (**\$7.30 as of Oct. 1st 2014**), a student must be registered before September 30 of that year and attend at least 3 days a week for a minimum of 2 periods per day. Sporadic users may also register, space permitting.

School daycares operate on a ratio of 20 students to 1 daycare educator. Our services provide a program of activities in keeping with the needs of the child in a safe environment supervised by qualified staff. Also, a daycare staff member is required to sit on the school's governing board.
